DUTIES (ILLUSTRATION ONLY):

The Program Manager generally manages the activities of the programs in the Family Health Service Unit on a daily basis. The Program Manager will be responsible for the following programs under the FSH unit: Maternal and Child Health (MCH), Family Planning Program (FP), Early Hearing Detection and Intervention (EHDI) and State System Development Initiative (SSDI). He/She is responsible to apply for program at the National and State levels. Additionally, the program manager will lead in program development, technical oversight, program quality assurance, policy development and advocacy, and developing professional relationships key stakeholders. The Program Manager will collaborate with other program managers to ensure that goals, mission, and vision of the FSM Department of Health and Social Affairs are achieved. He/She will report directly to the Assistant Secretary and /or Secretary of Health and Social Affairs and perform other duties as assigned.
