The Department of Health and Social Affairs of the Government of the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) seeks well qualified individual to fill the position of Program Manager – Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) for Infectious Diseases, Palikir, Pohnpei.

The Position: Liaison with CDC, DHSA Leadership and State Health Departments, to ensure that the project's goals, objectives, and strategies are achieved and that contractual requirements are met on time and within budget. Responsible for directing the project team with an integrated vision, applying effective leadership and strategic planning skills, management experience, interpersonal skills, and strong written and oral communication skills;

Provide overall management, strategic direction, and technical leadership to the project to achieve expected project results within budget and timeframe; serve as principal liaison to CDC and program implementer at State Government ensuring high levels of coordination, while nurturing relationships with all key stakeholders (including partner organization at the national and subnational level) on administrative, financial and programmatic matters related to the project;
