## **DUTIES (ILLUSTRATION ONLY):**

Provide professional criminal defense representative to Public Defender clients in both state and municipal court, represent a wide variety of cases ranging from simple misdemeanor cases to felony cases, prepares and represent criminal defendants in state appellate courts, represent client post-conviction hearings, prepares and file various type of remedial petition on behalf of clients as may be necessary, render legal advice on state criminal laws as needed, interprets court and other legal documents as necessary, prepare habeas corpus hearing when necessary, render advice on constitutional and fundamental rights to persons as necessary, protect civil rights of arrested persons and those confined in jail, act as counsel of record for all assigned criminal cases, supervise trial counselors, performs other duties as assigned.

## **Qualification Requirements:**

Graduation from an accredited college or university with a Trial Counselor Certificate and 1 year of progressively responsible law enforcement or criminal justice work experience.
