The Government of the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) seeks well qualified individuals to fill the position of **Climate Change Mitigation Consultant** at the Department of Environment, Climate Change and Emergency Management, FSM National Government.

The Position:

- * Review and stock taking of all national policies , programs and measures relevant to climate change and GHGs mitigation;
- * Collection, collation, analysis and archiving of data for the different sectors of the economy, with particular detail for the energy sector;
- * Development of Mitigation Scenarios (Emission Forecast) based on the available data from the GHG inventory, as well as socio-economic information, prepares a series of mitigation scenarios to 2030 and to 2050. This will include baseline scenario, whereby current trends continue, as well as at least two other scenarios showing how emissions may decrease if mitigation actions are taken.
- * Assessing technology option for the different mitigation options in various sectors, including cost-benefits analysis;
- * Identification, formulation and prioritization of programs containing measures to mitigate climate change within the framework of sustainable development.
- * Assessing institutional capacity-building requirements to sustain mitigation work and the related legal and institutional frameworks;
- * Training and capacity building for national experts and institutions on the use of appropriate technologies, methodologies and tools for assessment of mitigation options and development of mitigation scenarios.
- * Based on all the above analyses, drafting a National Mitigation Plan for key socio-economic sectors that will be directly be linked to FSM's NDC. A list of environmentally friendly mitigation technologies, including renewable energy technologies, will also be identified and assessed.
- * Preparing financially sound mitigation project profiles for implementation in the energy and other sectors, in order to attract public and private interest.
- * Organizing workshop for policy makers and other stakeholders to enhance their awareness on the importance of GHG emission reduction, which should be taken into consideration in national development planning.
- * Preparation of draft GHG mitigation reports for FBUR and TNC.
- * Following stakeholder consultations and review, finalizing the reports on GHG mitigation for FBUR and TNC and the National Mitigation Plan.

The Incumbent: Master's degree or equivalent as in energy science, climate change, natural resource management or any relevant qualification in related field plus five years of relevant experience in conducting mitigation analysis, development of mitigation options and their cost-benefit analysis for National Communication (NC) and/or Biennial Update Reports (BUR), presentation of NC and BUR to the UNFCCC and related activities.
