DUTIES (ILLURSTRATIVE ONLY):

Has an information and awareness raising function, as well as an advisory and organization function; monitor compliance and handle queries and complaints; although a DPO generally focusses on the processing of personal data, the INTERPOL DPO monitors the compliance of the processing operations of all data, whether personal or not; Establish and update processing procedures, particularly in relation to personal data, implement suitable ongoing training program for staff involved in data processing operations, inform and advise on the obligations related to the Organization's regulations on data protection, and document this activity (drafting of note, for instance), ensure in an independent manner, that the processing of personal data, including data relating to staff, is lawful and compliant with the Organization's regulations; and performs other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Graduated from an accredited college or university with a Bachelor's degree in Information Security, Network Systems, Criminal Justice or related field plus three (3) years of relevant experience in information technology management, cyber security and/or law enforcement or related work experience.

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
