**DUTIES (ILLUSTRATIVE ONLY):**

Plans, develops, administers, coordinates and evaluates all Nutrition and Health Education programs at the National and States levels; serves as Nutrition Planner; prepares written programs plans, budget and report as required; coordinates the Nutrition Educations curriculum with Division of Education in the FSM; coordinates and revise the 5 Year National Plan of Action on Food and Nutrition; coordinates and promotes and interagency approach to the provision of nutrition services in the States; identifies the needs of Sates staff regarding the production of quality food products and develops programs for meeting those needs; assist family food production program throughout the FSM; prepares grant applications to seek funding from the Federal, UN Agencies and WHO to assist various organizations with nutrition programs in the four States; seek for scholarships and fund to support academic training on Nutrition and Dietetics; provides technical training on Food Service Management, Clinical Dietetics and nutrition education to program staffs in the FSM States; coordinates FSM National Nutrition Survey and Micro-nutrients studies and to conduct school nutrition survey in all four states; assist FSM States in their Vitamin A Deficiency and vermoz programs by providing medicine supplies and training; coordinate training on Baby Friendly Hospital Initiative in each of the four states and monitor the preparation on Internal and External Assessment of BFHI; conducts and assesses of health education needs, resources, leadership knowledge, attitudes and practices as the basis for planning services and educational programs to meet the health needs of the FSM States; performs other duties as assigned.

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

Graduation from a recognized college or university with a Degree in nutrition, dietetics or related fields plus three (3) years of progressively responsible work experience in nutrition or related field.
